

## Capital One Fostering a Future Scholarship Application

### Background:

The Capital One Fostering a Future Scholarship is open to children adopted from foster care at or after age 13 to provide increased opportunities for advanced education. The Children's Action Network and the Dave Thomas Foundation for Adoption are founders and administrators of the scholarship program.

### Eligibility:

The specific eligibility requirements are as follows:

- Applicants must have been adopted from the United States foster care system at or after the age of thirteen.
- Applicants must be graduating high school seniors.
- Applicants may only apply one time
- Qualifying grade point average must be maintained or improved throughout the applicant's senior year.
- Applicants must demonstrate financial need.
- Employees of Capital One, Wendy's, Children's Action Network or the Dave Thomas Foundation for Adoption are not eligible for scholarship funds.

### Application Requirements:

- A completed application.
- Three short essays written by the student. The essay topics are described on page 3.
- Demonstration of financial need.
- Two letters of recommendation. One letter should represent a teacher or administrator who is familiar with the student's work and accomplishments. The second letter should come from a significant person in the child's life (i.e. social worker, coach, etc.). Both letters should reflect the writer's knowledge of the student's achievements, improvements, and personal needs. Please attach to the application.
- A recent photo of applicant. Please attach to the application.
- The student's most recent high school transcript. Please attach to the application.
- First semester grades. Please forward first semester grades when available.
- A copy of applicant's adoption certificate. Please attach to the application.
- The application must be postmarked no later than April 20, 2011.

Scholarships for two-year institutions will total up to \$5,000 and scholarships for four-year institutions will total up to \$10,000. Please note \$10,000 scholarships will be awarded in two installments. A maximum of ten scholarships will be awarded in 2011.
